The Public Broadcasting Institution of the Republic of Indonesia Radio LPP RRI with the existence of 69 stations from Sabang to Merauke makes the reach of the distribution of news information become massive. Based on government regulation PP number 11 of 2005 concerning LPP, it states that RRI is a public broadcasting institution established by the state independently and for the benefit of the community. The challenges of the era of media existence amidst information convergence and disruption have made RRI continue to develop in the face of various realities where society is easily exposed to misleading or even incorrect information or hoaxes.

The area of Indonesia from Sabang to Merauke based on data from the Ministry of Home Affairs in 2024 consisting of around 17,508 islands spread across 38 provinces with 416 regencies and 98 cities makes Indonesia's reach very wide (Ministry of Home Affairs, 2024). The population in Indonesia is also very large based on data from the Central Statistics Agency (BPS) in 2024 reaching more than 281 million people with a land area of up to 1.9 million km² and ethnicity in Indonesia is also very large reaching 1340 ethnic groups making the challenge of distributing news information to reach all groups (Central Statistics Agency, 2024).

In maintaining the integrity of the Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia, reliable, valid, verified news information with checks and rechecks from all lines is a must so that public accountability can be obtained for the data and facts presented. The dangers of hoaxes for Indonesia are very significant and have a wide impact on all aspects of people's lives. The polarization of society due to hoaxes divides society, strengthens differences between socio-political and religious groups. Hoaxes can also trigger violent social unrest and conflict between communities. Hoaxes also damage the reputation of individuals, organizations or institutions towards public trust. With the spread of hoaxes, people become skeptical and do not believe in true information, making it difficult to spread accurate information.

The current situation of the Indonesian nation which is also multi-party and groups and streams makes it vulnerable to national and state life. Hoax issues are one way to attack and even bring down those who do not have the same interests in various things. In this case, the state must not lose so that with the existing institutional elements and human resources, RRI becomes the vanguard of information resilience sources providing reliable sources. RRI provides certainty of information so that resilience becomes more real so that the public can absorb reliable sources of information through news that is widely distributed with existing networks. To overcome the dissemination of reliable information, there must be an effort to create valid,

checked and rechecked information based on accurate data and facts. In today's era, of course, mastering online social media with multimedia discipline is very important in preventing hoaxes because there is a lot of misleading information circulating from these media. The public is exposed to and even trusts sources of information created from social or online media that have not necessarily been verified by the press council or mainstream media institutions, so that massive distribution occurs quickly.

In the midst of the era of media disruption and convergence, RRI as a public broadcasting institution established by the government must be able to ensure reliable information to the public with accurate, balanced, transparent and reliable data and facts. Gap: Although LPP RRI has carried out its public broadcasting function in presenting reliable information amidst the rise of hoaxes, its strategic role has not been fully designed, measured and utilized in the framework of national defense based on strategic theories such as Ends-Ways-Means, as it should be in a universal defense strategy.

Research Questions

1. What is the role of LPP RRI in forming information resilience as part of the national defense strategy?
2. What are the challenges and opportunities faced by RRI in countering the spread of hoaxes and disinformation?
3. How prepared are human resources and technology at RRI in supporting the national information defense function?
