



# TEACHING THE MEANING OF RAMADHAN TO STUDENTS OF MIFTAHUL JANNAH ORPHANAGE IN INCREASING EMPATHY TOWARDS OTHERS

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#### **Abstract**

This study investigated effective methods to teach the meaning of Ramadhan to children at Miftahul Jannah Orphanage to enhance their empathy towards others. Traditional approaches to Ramadhan education often focus on rituals, potentially neglecting the social and humanitarian aspects. This study explored the use of experiential learning, social activities, and engaging media to foster empathy and a deeper understanding of the spiritual and social values of Ramadhan. The results showed that these methods significantly improved understanding of the meaning of Ramadhan and encouraged positive behavioral changes, increasing social sensitivity and empathy among children. This study highlights the importance of innovative and contextual approaches in religious education to foster caring and socially responsible individuals.

Through direct experience, such as social activities and sharing with others, students not only understand the meaning of Ramadan conceptually, but also feel and experience the values of empathy in real life. This approach is able to develop social sensitivity and strengthen their sense of concern for others more effectively (Lestari, 2023). No less important, media and inspirational stories can also be an effective means of instilling the meaning of Ramadan. By utilizing visual media and real-life stories from influential figures, students can more easily understand and internalize these positive values. Modern technology and media can be utilized to support the learning process to make it more interesting and meaningful (Sari & Utami, 2022). Overall, innovative and contextual teaching of the meaning of Ramadan is needed to help students instill a sense of empathy and social concern in depth. Through an experiential approach, social activities, and the use of creative media, students can understand and experience the spiritual and social

#### LITERATURE REVIEWS

According to Sari and Utami (2022), the use of visual media such as videos, pictures, and real stories from inspirational figures helps students internalize spiritual and social meanings.

#### **METHOD**

This study uses a mixed-methods approach, combining qualitative and quantitative data collection techniques. This study involved children from the Miftahul Jannah Orphanage. Data collection methods include:

- Pre and Post-Intervention Survey: Given before and after the Ramadan program to assess changes in understanding, attitudes, and empathy levels.
- Observation: Direct observation of children's engagement in social activities and interactions to evaluate their social behavior and empathy.
- Focus Group Discussion:Conducted with children to gather in-depth perspectives on their experiences and the impact of the methods applied.
- Analysis of activities and materials: Assessment of the media used and the activities carried out.

#### RESULT AND DISCUSSION

#### **Increasing Understanding of the Meaning of Ramadan**

The results of the study showed that through the application of experiential learning methods and social activities during the month of Ramadan, students experienced a significant increase in understanding the spiritual and social meaning of Ramadan. Before participating in the program, most students only understood fasting as a ritual obligation without touching on moral and social aspects. After participating in activities that combined lectures, discussions, and direct experiences, they were able to mention various values such as caring, sharing, and empathy for others.

#### **Changes in Attitudes and Behavior**

In addition to increasing understanding, there is a development in the attitudes and behavior of students. They become more concerned about others, as seen from their desire to participate in activities such as sharing food, giving alms, and helping relatives and local residents. This change in attitude shows that an approach that integrates direct experience can foster social sensitivity and strengthen empathy.

#### The Influence of Visual Media and Inspirational Stories

The use of visual media and inspirational stories has proven effective in strengthening the internalization of moral values and empathy. Students actively respond to videos and stories of inspirational figures for the changes in attitude and sense of caring they experience after listening to the material. They also show increased motivation and interest in learning about the meaning of Ramadan through these media.

#### The Role of Social Activities in Increasing Empathy

Social activities, such as sharing food and clothes, help them experience firsthand how meaningful it is to give and share with others in need. Many students feel proud and happy when they are able to help others during Ramadan, which emphasizes that direct experience is very effective in instilling empathy in them. They also feel closer to others and Ramadan becomes not just a ritual, but a deep emotional experience.

#### **Increased Social Awareness After Activities**

Students who initially only understood the meaning of Ramadhan theoretically showed real changes in social sensitivity. They became more attentive to their surroundings, such as paying attention to neighbors in trouble and visiting relatives they rarely visited. This shows that the experiential approach is able to encourage them to become individuals who are more sensitive to the social realities around them.

## The Impact of Social Activities on Students' Self-Efficacy

In addition to empathy, social activities during Ramadan can increase students' self-confidence and sense of belonging to their community. They feel that the small contribution they make can have a positive impact and make them more confident in their attitudes and behavior. This also increases the sense of social responsibility that is important for character development.

#### **Student Involvement and Motivation**

From the results of observations and interviews, it is seen that students who are actively involved in social activities and discussions have a higher level of motivation in following the learning process. They feel that the activities are relevant and directly touch their lives. This involvement increases their commitment to the meaning of Ramadan so that they not only know but also experience and practice these values.

#### The Influence of Modern Media Use

The use of visual media and stories of inspirational figures can stimulate the emotions of students and make them understand the meaning of Ramadan more deeply. Students show high enthusiasm for the material presented through videos and other visual media, this increases the opportunity to strengthen the internalization of values about empathy and kindness.

#### The Role of Teachers and Facilitators in Guiding Students

In addition to the methods used, the role of facilitators and teachers greatly determines the success of this empathy learning process. They are able to guide students to understand that the meaning of Ramadan is not just a ritual, but a spiritual and social experience that must be experienced in real and continuous ways in their lives.

### **Continuity of Learning**

The results of the study also show that the effectiveness of this method can be sustainable if supported by routine programs and reinforcement from the surrounding environment. Direct experience and social activities carried out continuously will further strengthen the character of empathy of students and make them individuals who care about others, not only during Ramadan but throughout the future.
